2nd Jesus...had been invited to the wedding

Is Jesus at the centre of your marriage or your life? Pray for Charles and Kate. Pray for the peace negotiations for Ukraine and for the Holy Land. Pray for humanitarian aid to reach the people of Gaza. Pray for those in or affected by domestic violence. Pray for the Hub and for the Repair Cafe.

3rd They have no more wine

We all experience disasters, some great, some small. How do we deal with them – do we put prayer first, or only after all else has failed? Pray that we can be effective in reaching out to young and old with the love of Jesus. Pray for Toddlers at St Johns. Pray for the selection and appointment of a Youth Pastor and other decisions on staffing. Pray for the prayer meetings being held this week and that we will be faithful in prayer.

4th Do whatever he tells you

Ask the Lord to guide you. Pray for the world, the United Nations and national governments. Pray for deliverance for those caught up in human slavery and trafficking. Pray for the organisations tackling these problems. Pray for Alpha, our guests and the helpers.

5th You have saved the best till now

Place your trust in our God. He comes alongside us in our difficulties, as we ask him in prayer to sustain us. Give thanks and pray for those who preach the gospel. Ask our Father to help us listen to the concerns of those around us. Pray for those whose health investigations and treatment have been delayed. Pray for Alpha, the guests and the helpers.

12th Seek first his kingdom and righteousness...

Pray that we will be open to God's guidance and be prepared to share his good news. Pray for those God has placed on your heart. Pray for our office staff and volunteers. Pray that we will continue to explore and use our spiritual gifts. Pray for Just42. Pray for the Children's Society. Pray for the Valentine Extravaganza.

13th Do not worry about tomorrow

Our future is unknown, but it is in God's hands. Put your trust in him. Is the Lord prompting you to repent and seek his forgiveness? Pray for the healing of relationships and hurts, some of these due to historic or current racial or domestic abuse. Pray for the emergency services. Pray for the selection of an architect to advise us on how to develop the church buildings.

Matthew 17: 1 - 9

16th [Jesus] was transfigured before them

Worship our Lord in his glory. Give thanks to the Lord for his grace and forgiveness. Pray that we will be a church that welcomes all. Pray for those caught up in conflict throughout the world. Pray for the efforts to secure peace. Pray for the work of The Children's Society. Pray for the Hub. Pray for our government and that decisions made will be for the benefit of all.

17th His face shone like the sun

18th (Ash Wednesday) This is my Son...listen to him

Sit for a while and let Jesus fill your thoughts. Let him fill you with joy in his presence and the desire to share that joy with those around us. Pray for yourself and the people of our benefice that we can step out in faith, empowered by the Holy Spirit. Pray for the services on Sunday morning and evening.

Matthew 4: 1 - 11

23rd Tempted by the devil

Each of us humans can be tempted in some way. Pray to be equipped with the full armour of God to withstand the devil's attacks. Pray for those who live or work in residential or care homes in this area. Pray for those receiving end of life care. Pray for Suffolk County Council and East Suffolk District Council, for their work and that decisions made will be to the benefit of all. Pray for the CPAS. Pray for the Middle East. Pray for the Hub.

24th [Man lives] on every word that comes from the mouth of God

Let God show you how his word can guide you in your life. Pray that we can share the love of Jesus with those around us, at home and in Woodbridge. Pray for Toddlers at St Johns. Pray for growth of the ministry in our benefice to children and young people. Pray for the NHS, social care and our medical centres. Pray for Open Doors.

25th Do not put the Lord you God to the test

We are warned against saying things to God such as "if you do this..." Do we welcome the light of Christ into the shadows of our life? Ask the Spirit to show you where you are still in darkness. Pray for the Wednesday congregation. Pray for action to be taken to reduce the impact of climate change. Pray for Ukraine and those from the Ukraine who are living locally. Pray for Alpha.

26th Away from me Satan

Pray that you will not fall for the enemy's lies. Give thanks that we have a certain hope and future in eternity. Ask God to show you how you can share his love. Pray for the food banks and the Salvation Army. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who are being killed or persecuted for their faith. Pray for Tear Fund.

27th Worship the Lord your God and serve him only

We are called to serve God within his church – have you found your place? Pray that we will become an eco-friendly benefice. Pray that our love for one another will flow into the community. Pray for the ministry of healing and for sensitivity towards those struggling with long term ailments. Pray for our farmers, those involved in agriculture and those involved in food production. Pray for the Sunday services.
