




- Create and manage an agreed communications strategy for the church in its outworking throughout the year, ensuring GDPR compliance
- Responsibility for the promotion of the church communications including social media and the church's website.
- Promoting the church via internal and external media, including creating and overseeing the printing of publicity for events as directed, liaising with external suppliers, where appropriate.

To ensure that risk assessments are carried out and reviewed as required, and that the risk is managed
appropriately.

To carry out any other reasonable duties and on-off projects within the overall function of the role.


